Visitors will be able to speak within the allotted ten minutes. If several visitors wish to express similar views it is suggested that a spokesperson should speak on behalf of the group. When visitors wishing to speak arrive at the meeting, they should give their names to the Clerk and say that they wish to speak. To avoid arguments and keep the length of meetings to a reasonable level, Councillors will not enter into discussion with visitors during the allocated public participation time. Apart from the initial participation session, the public are not allowed to speak in the meeting.
